The Fairfield Historical Society is a nonprofit Section 501 (3) which owns and runs the Fairfield History House. It serves as a focal point of town history and a safe location for a unique collection of Fairfield memorabilia and artifacts. It serves as a repository for area residents who have period items and family memorabilia that they want preserved.

The History House is also a local destination and brings people to Fairfield. A major responsibility of the society is the maintenance of the History House and barn. Visitors tour the museum with docents explaining the story of each room and the artifacts they contain. Visitors also come to research local history and do genealogical work. School children learn what life was like in the early 1900s and what a rich history this area has.

2022 was a busy expensive year. Scraping, replacing rotted wood and painting of the History House was started. The south and west sides of the house are completed and a small landing and stairs were replaced on the east side. More trees have been removed. In 2023 we hope to have the rest of the History House completed. Thank you to Kevin Violette for overseeing this project.

Volunteer staff continued the regular maintenance and service work: Jennifer Morriseau maintained the gardens, Barbara Gunvaldsen processed research inquiries and Peggy Blair, Kathy Violette, Pam Bryan, Shannon King and Shirley Duplessis maintained the History House and documented memorabilia and artifacts that were donated. Bill Blair facilitated maintenance work in the house, barn and the grounds. Volunteers also gave many tours.

The spring and fall Barn and Bake Sales were held and the Christmas Open House was well attended.
